



## Colorscope Chenango Arts Festival September 12&13, 2026 Non-Profit Row Guidelines

Welcome to Colorscope's Non-Profit Row. The idea is simple: we offer space within our Festival to local non-profit groups and organizations so that they can present themselves and their mission to the community. In exchange, those organizations offer a free arts-related activity to our community to create any even deeper and varied arts experience. It's a win-win! We encourage all non-profit organizations in Chenango County to apply to participate.

For the 2026 Festival, Non-Profit Row will again be located in its own tent on the front lawn of Guernsey Memorial Library to the right of their main entrance. This means organizations will not be required to provide or set up their own tent, table, or chairs. Space is limited to 7 participating organizations so get your applications in early!

### **Guidelines and expectations:**

- Non-profits will be provided with one 6-foot table and two chairs inside of a 20'x20' tent.
- Organizations must provide all their own supplies for their required art project.
- Non-profits are expected to be present at their assigned table for the entirety of the Festival hours: Saturday 10am-6pm and Sunday 11am-5pm. Non-profits that wish to only participate on one day must find another non-profit with which to share the space and fee. Booths should be staffed the entire time. Please ask a neighbor to keep an eye on your table if you need to take a brief break. Note that you must participate both days.
- Non-profits are free to promote their own mission in any way they choose.
- Non-profits are also expected to promote the mission of Colorscope by offering a free arts activity to members of our audience.
- Enjoy the weekend, and thank you for making Colorscope even bigger and better!

**Fee:** \$45 participation fee per organization. Space is limited to 7 organizations and a waitlist will be created in case of cancellations.

**To apply:** Organizations will be selected at Colorscope's Board of Directors meeting on July 8, 2026. The strength of an organization's free arts project weighs heavily on the selection process. Applications must be received via email to [director@colorscope.org](mailto:director@colorscope.org) by July 1, 2026.
